Junior Summer Terms and Conditions of Enrolment

MAKING A BOOKING

- Junior Summer is part of the International Language Homestays group and bookings are processed by its UK student reservations office in Margate, Kent.
- To make a booking, download the enrolment form from the website www.juniorsummer.com and return it to us via post, fax or email, with a deposit of £250 (payable by bank transfer).
- Fees of £1100 per person for the full programme are fully inclusive. (Please see brochure for full details).
- A deposit of £250 is required at the time of booking and the full balance of £850 must be paid at least 4 weeks before the course starts.
- Confirmation will be provided within 2 working days of receiving the registration form and deposit.

NB: Please do not make travel arrangements until the course booking has been confirmed.

- Payment should be made by bank transfer and is required four weeks before arrival. Transfers should be made to:

- Please send us a copy of the bank transfer documents.
- Any bank charges incurred during payment are the student's responsibility. The amount invoiced must be received in full. Any underpayment must be settled before the course starts.
- Please ensure your name, your child's name and booking reference are quoted on the bank transfer documents.
- Fees do not include the following:
 - Travel to the UK
 - Travel or Medical Insurance
 - Excess baggage expenses
 - Pocket money*

*Junior summer recommends a minimum of £100 pocket money for the two week programme to cover expenses, such as ice creams, postcards and personal shopping. Students are not encouraged to make major or sizeable purchases during their stay.

● All fees paid are non-refundable unless we receive a cancellation notice at least 4 weeks before the scheduled course start date, when a £250 cancellation fee is charged. All cancellations must be notified in writing by post, fax or email to the school and are only validated with written acknowledgement from the company.

- We cannot refund fees to students who start the course late, miss lessons for any reason, or leave early. Upon receipt of full fees, a formal letter of invitation can be issued, if required (i.e. in support of visa applications). If a letter of invitation needs to be sent by courier (eg DHL) a supplement of £50 is payable.
 - Students must have appropriate travel and medical insurance before travelling to the UK. This should include cover for any medical expenses while in the UK.
 - Enrolments are accepted on the understanding that the student has no illness or infirmity, which might adversely affect the success of the stay.
- In making a booking, the parent or guardian gives their full consent for Junior Summer to act on their behalf in the case of a medical emergency.

GENERAL

- If two or more students of the same sex request to share a room, we will do our best to arrange this, but it cannot be guaranteed.
- Junior Summer regrets that we are unable to accept students who are beginners in English.
- Junior Summer expects students to be punctual and polite and to try to speak English at all times. We ask that students respect the school and each other.
- Junior Summer retains the right to dismiss any student for reasons of serious misconduct, at the discretion of the company, without refund of fees. By completing the registration form, the parent/guardian accepts that their child will be expected to adhere to the following rules in particular, and that failure to do so may lead to the student being asked to leave the course and return home at their own or their parents'/guardian's expense.
- No alcohol, drugs or weapons are allowed.
- Dormitories, other than the student's own, are strictly out of bounds.
- There must not be any sexual contact between students.
- Students must not interfere with fire safety equipment.
- Students must not cause deliberate injury to each other or damage to property.
- Students must not leave the school unless accompanied by a member of staff.
- Junior Summer reserves the right to use photographs taken during courses in its promotional material. If a parent or guardian wishes that their child's photograph should not appear in this material, they should write to Junior Summer within one month of the end of the programme attended. These photos have no commercial or contractual value.
- Junior Summer reserves the right to alter the activity programme due to circumstances beyond our control (eg adverse weather conditions). This will not be to the detriment of the programme.
